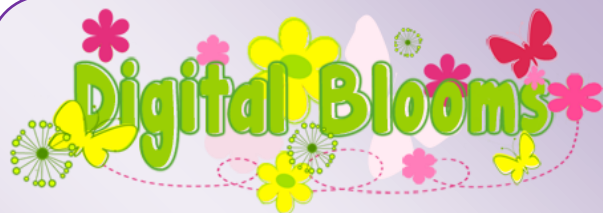
Andrew Churches
