Module 1 – Booting Up (90 Minutes)

In the compulsory module *Booting Up* teachers will learn a fundamental framework for understanding key cybersafety issues. The relationship between a student’s online behaviour and their social, emotional and digital development is explored to strengthen a teacher’s understanding of their student’s place in the digital world.

Module Two— The Bottom Line (1 hour)

The Bottom Line module highlights a teacher’s legal responsibilities to the students under his or her care and explores the implications for teachers of different online activities. Teachers will workshop strategies and safety guidelines and will learn the importance of keeping both learners and educators safe in online environments.

Module Three— Plugging into the Curriculum (1 hour)

The Plugging into the Curriculum module is a practical hands-on workshop for teachers. In addition to the suite of the ACMA’s cybersafety resources, participants will learn how to apply cybersafety messages to the general capabilities outlined in the new Australian Curriculum.

Module Four— Teaching the Five Ps of Digital Citizenship(1 hour)

The Teaching the Five Ps of Digital Citizenship module introduces teachers to the rights and obligations that come with being a responsible digital citizen. The module will focus on the skills and habits that teachers can teach their students to help them critically analyse their actions, both online and offline, and the subsequent consequences.
