#### SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Students are required to submit one TYPED written work limited to **300 words** in answer to the following question:

"Which of the Sister Cities of Cairns would you choose to visit, why, and what would you bring back?"

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- **1.** The competition is open to all students in the Cairns city area attending Primary and Secondary schools. Entry is free.
- **2.** Entry form must be completed personally by the entrant and signed by the teacher, verifying the entry is the sole work of the student.
- **3.** Closing date for submitting entries is **Tuesday 18 June.** Entries received after this date will not be judged.
- 4. ONE entry per student will be accepted.
- 5. Tracing and computer generated clipart are not allowed.
- **6.** Judging criteria: quality of presentation; originality; relevance to the theme; creativity; visual impact.
- 7. Entries without appropriate entry form will not be judged.
- **8.** Your entry form must be attached to the BACK of your entry. Ensure ALL sections are completed. The Cairns Sister Cities Committee cannot take responsibility for entries displaying incomplete or incorrectly completed entry forms.
- **9.** Entries will be judged according to the judging criteria. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 10. The judging panel will include members of the Cairns Sister Cities Advisory Committee.
- **12.** The Cairns Sister Cities Committee reserves the right to use entries for promotional purposes.
- 13. Entries will remain the property of Cairns Regional Council.
- **14.** Winners will be notified and can accept prizes at the Sister Cities National Day on 5 July. The event will be held between 3.30pm and 6pm on the Eastern Lawn of the Esplanade.
